## **ReGenesis: Now Operating Northside Clinic**

ReGenesis Health Care, which provides affordable quality care based on need and income, is now operating in the Northside Clinic under the direction of the Edward Via School of Osteopathic Medicine. On Aug. 13, 2021, ReGenesis began its patient intake and a grand opening ceremony was held on Aug. 31, 2021, to welcome staff.

The Northside Clinic was established as a part of the revitalization effort to address critical health indicators for Northside residents and to provide referral services for those who are minimally insured or have no insurance. ReGenesis Chief Operating Officer Crystal Cohen provided her opinion on the collaboration: "The partnership between ReGenesis and VCOM will provide a unique opportunity for experience within diverse populations and clinical situations. Because community health centers provide unique environments to teach students to develop culturally appropriate care and unique delivery methods for clinical situations, this new collaboration will be monumental for our city, patients, and community at-large by increasing access to health care and improving the quality of care provided to underserved populations."


#### **COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER JOINS NDG STAFF**
